Editor In Chief

The Daily Nebraskan is accepting applications for the 1991-92 editor in chief. Applicants must have one year of newspaper experience, preferably at the Daily Nebraskan, and be a student at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

The editor in chief formulates editorial policy, determines guidelines for the daily operation of the newsroom, hires the senior editorial staff, helps determine the content of the editorial page, prepares the editorial salary budget and reports to the Publications Board.

The editor earns \$950/month from August 1 through the end of second semester (\$475 in December).
