

LSU's O'Neal off injury list for NCAA tourney

Shaquille O'Neal plans to come back to Louisiana State for his junior year. The Connecticut Huskies would like to end his sophomore season tonight.

O'Neal, the nation's best big man, said he's not in any hurry to leave 22nd-ranked LSU for the big bucks he's sure to earn in the NBA, where he would probably be the No. 1 overall pick this June.

"Most likely I'll return. I love LSU. I love my teammates. I'm having fun," he said as the Tigers (20-9) prepared for their NCAA Midwest Regional first-round game against Connecticut (18-10) tonight in Minneapolis.

Most important to LSU is that O'Neal, the nation's leading rebounder, is off the injury list. A hairline fracture in his left leg sidelined O'Neal for LSU's last two games. The Tigers lost both, including an SEC tourney game with Auburn.

Coach Dale Brown feels O'Neal's return should get the Tigers back on the right track.

"We've just got to get back on the roll," he said. "We had won seven straight conference games and we've got to get back in the flow."

Huskies coach Jim Calhoun said O'Neal is the most dominant center his club has seen.

"I don't remember us facing a guy who averages 27.7 points, almost 15 rebounds and had (135) blocked shots," he said.

In tonight's other first-round Midwest games, 17th-ranked East Tennessee State (28-4) meets Iowa (20-10), No. 6 Duke (26-7) faces Northeast Louisiana (25-7) and No. 11 Nebraska (26-7) opposes Xavier of Ohio (21-9).

First-round games are also scheduled tonight in College Park, Md. (East), Louisville, Ky. (Southeast) and Salt Lake City (West). Eight more games will be played Friday.

Second-seeded Syracuse (26-5) knows that Richmond has an impressive list of big-name NCAA tournament victims and doesn't want to get on that list.

"They won't catch us off guard," coach Jim Boheim said of the Spiders, who come to Cole Field House as the 15th seed.

Oklahoma State (22-7) opens tonight against New Mexico (20-9).

After that, it's North Carolina State (19-10) and Southern Mississippi (21-7), followed by Purdue (17-11) against Temple (21-9).

Southeast
Florida State can score, but Seminoles coach Pat Kennedy feels his team got to the final 64 with defense. "I think this has been my best defensive team," said Kennedy, whose seventh-seeded team will meet 10th-seeded Southern Cal tonight in Louisville.

Florida State trailed Louisville by 20 points early in the second half of the Metro Conference title game. The Seminoles (20-10) then outscored Louisville 40-13 in the final 17 minutes to win the game and an automatic berth.

In the other games, second-seeded Indiana (27-4) faces Coastal Carolina, third-seeded Kansas (22-7) meets New Orleans (23-7), and No. 6 Pitt (20-10) meets No. 11 Georgia (17-12).

West

If there's a home-court edge in the West, it belongs to 10th-seeded Brigham Young (20-12), which only has to travel from Provo to Salt Lake City to play seventh-seeded Virginia (21-11) in its opening-round game.

The Cougars are led by 7-foot-6 center Shawn Bradley, the nation's top shot-blocker (165), who also averages 15.2 points and 7.8 rebounds. But at 210 pounds, Bradley's first year of college basketball also has been marked by a bruising, sometimes losing, battle with shorter, bulkier foes.

The Cavaliers boast a pair of strong, stocky centers — 6-9, 240-pound sophomore Ted Jeffries and Matt Blundin, a 6-7, 232-pounder who was a backup quarterback on the football team.

In the other first-round games, third-seeded Seton Hall (22-8) faces No. 14 Pepperdine (22-8), No. 6 New Mexico State (23-5) meets No. 11 Creighton (23-7), and the No. 2 seed, Arizona (26-6), plays St. Francis, Pa. (24-7).
