Alleged sexual incident

Day to face suspension

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. (AP) — Todd Day's stepfather says the Arkansas basketball star has been suspended from the Razorback team for a year, apparently in connection with a sexual incident in an athletic dorm.

The Arkansas Democrat newspaper at Little Rock said Ted Anderson, a basketball coach at Hamilton High School in Memphis, Tenn., claimed that Day, his stepson, was being railroaded.

"Todd won't even be able to be eligible for a year," Anderson said in a telephone interview with the Democrat. He called the punishment for players involved in the Feb. 27 inci-

dent "unfairly consistent."

University officials and lawyers for four players disciplined by the school's All University Judicial Board have declined to specify what action was taken by the board. School officials said the board's report was released to those directly involved Monday, but details of the action were sealed from public release by federal law.

The judicial board's action stemmed from an incident in which a 34-year-old woman said she was sexually assaulted. She implicated four members of the Razorbacks' nationally ranked team.
