Day to face suspension

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. (AP) --Todd Day's stepfather says the Ar-kansas basketball star has been suspended from the Razorback team for a year, apparently in connection with a sexual incident in an athletic dorm.

The Arkansas Democrat newspaper at Little Rock said Ted Anderson, a basketball coach at Hamilton High School in Memphis, Tenn., claimed that Day, his stepson, was being rail-

"Todd won't even be able to be eligible for a year," Anderson said in a telephone interview with the Democrat. He called the punishment for players involved in the Feb. 27 inci-

dent "unfairly consistent."

University officials and lawyers for four players disciplined by the school's All University Judicial Board have declined to specify what action was taken by the board. School offi-cials said the board's report was re-leased to those directly involved Monday, but details of the action were sealed from public release by federal
