The Nebraska men's gymnastics team has signed Richard Grace of Millard South and Rick Kieffer of Austin, Texas, to letters-of-intent.

According to Nebraska coach Francis Allen, Grace and Kieffer are half of the nation's top recruits. "In my opinion there are four

blue-chip, bona fide Olympic-caliber gymnasts coming out of high school this year," Allen said in a press release, "and we've got two of them."

The Huskers will lose seniors Brad Bryan and Ted Dimas from this year's team.

After four more halted drives, Grant, who finished with 70 yards on four of 10 passing attempts, hit tight end Johnny Mitchell on a 53-yard touchdown pass.

Fittingly for the defense, the last score came when free safety Jamie Weyers picked up a fumble and scampered to the end zone.

"(The defense) played with pretty good intensity," Osborne said. "The offense generally had the better of it last Saturday, but today I'd say the defense played pretty well."


