

# Curator begins Plains center reign

Martha Kennedy, collections coordinator with Lincoln City Libraries, has taken the reins as curator of the Center for Great Plains Studies.

Kennedy succeeded Jon Nelson, the collection's first curator, who will retire Wednesday.

Before assuming her position with the Lincoln City Libraries, Kennedy was museum registrar at the Nebraska State Museum of History in Lincoln

and was curator of photographs with the California Historical Society Library in San Francisco. Kennedy holds masters' degrees in art history and library science from the University of California at Berkeley.

She has presented workshops on the care and preservation of photographs and the identification and care of historical photographs. Kennedy also has an article forthcoming in Nebraska History magazine dealing with her research on "Nebraska's Women Photographers."

resident instruction in the College of Human Development at Pennsylvania State University (1979-82). He served on the Penn State faculty from 1973 to 1979.

Spanier was a social science analyst for the U.S. Bureau of the Census on a visiting appointment in 1978. He holds a bachelor's and a master's degree in sociology from Iowa State University and a doctorate, also in sociology, from Northwestern University.

Spanier was unavailable for comment on his candidacy Wednesday.

A fifth candidate, Judith Kuipers of California State University at Fresno, withdrew from the search process after accepting the position of chancellor of the University of Wisconsin at La Crosse.
