

## Men's basketball tickets on sale

UNL students may purchase tickets for the upcoming men's basketball season this week, Cornhusker athletic ticket manager Joe Selig said. Tickets may be purchased from 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Athletic Ticket Office, 17 South Stadium.

The cost of a student ticket is \$35, and spouse tickets are \$70. A student ticket does not include the four games that will be played over the semester break. However, tickets for those four games will be on sale at a later date with special student rates.

## Pirates clinch N.L. East title

PITTSBURGH (AP) — The Pittsburgh Pirates have officially ended the pennant race that never was. The Pirates became the first National League team in 13 years to win consecutive division championships, beating the Philadelphia Phillies 2-1 Sunday behind Doug Drabek for their eighth East Division title since division play began in 1969. Unlike last year, when they waited the last weekend of the season to clinch, this title came easy. The Pirates took the lead on April 1 and never gave it up, building their lead from 2 1/2 games in late July to the current 13 1/2 — the biggest East Division runaway since the Mets won 15 in 1988.

for 15 yards up the middle and a first down.

Nothing unusual, Hobert said. "We knew we'd have the middle open and that's what we were looking for," Hobert said.

"That's four-down territory. There was no doubt that we'd go for it."

And the Huskies had no question that they'd march down the field against the Huskers, Hobert said.

"I thought we had them all night long," he said. "I just wasn't throwing strikes in the first half."

But of the four touchdown strikes in the second half, the shortest drive was the most crucial, James said. After Washington snatched the lead on a 15-yard touchdown run by Bryant, Husker quarterback Keithen McCant fumbled at Nebraska's 33-yard line.

Aided by a pass interference call against Nebraska cornerback Kenny Wilhite on third-and-19, Hobert scored from three yards out, capping the nine-play drive.

"When the defense finally contributed in getting the turnover, that just jacked us all up," James said.

Washington's defense held Nebraska to just one first down in the third quarter and four in the fourth quarter. After totaling 199 yards in the first half, Nebraska gained just 109 yards after the intermission.

"We just weren't getting the job done in the first half," defensive tackle Steve Emtman said. "We started playing team defense, battled it out and got the job done."

But after recording eight tackles, Emtman said it was one of his roughest jobs.

"This is one of the toughest games I've ever played in," Emtman said. "They're physical, no doubt. And there is no doubt they're back, if they were ever gone."

Hobert said Nebraska fans' ovation as Washington left after the game was "incredible."

"If I was a fan, I would have been applauding, too," Hobert said. "That was a hell of a game."
