Tickets for migration game to Colorado on sale next week
The annual student football game migration will be to Boulder, Colo., for the Nebraska-Colorado game Nov. 2.
The three-day sale for Nebraska's allotment of tickets will be conducted next Tuesday through Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. The first two days of the sale will be restricted to students who purchased football season tickets. Remaining tickets will be made available to any full-time student on the third day.
Tickets cost \$30. Each student purchasing a ticket must present a student ID and personal payment. Married students may purchase tickets for their spouses upon presentation of their marriage certificates.

Volleyball team drops in rankings after two weekend losses
After losing two games last weekend, the Nebraska volleyball team slipped from fifth to ninth on the American Volleyball Coaches Association Poll released Tuesday.
The Cornhuskers also dropped from seventh to 10th on the Volleyball Monthly poll.
Stanford remains No. 1 in both polls and is followed by UCLA.

Nebraska men's golf team finishes 12th in Iowa tournament
The Nebraska men's golf team finished 12th in a 17-team field at the 1991 Northern Intercollegiate Golf Tournament in Iowa City, Iowa. Ohio State won the 54-hole tourney with a score of 878, two strokes ahead of Wisconsin. Nebraska finished 38 strokes back at 916.
The top Nebraska finisher was Brad Dubisar, who tied for 20th at 225. Other Cornhusker scores were Craig Poet, 228; Chad Dubisar, 233; Jeff Rafferty, 235; and Steve Reiter, 236.
