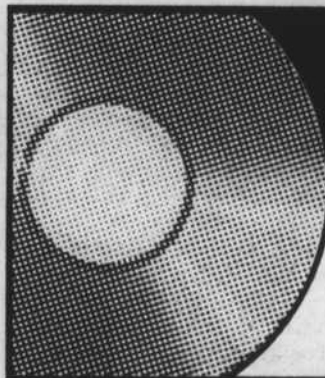

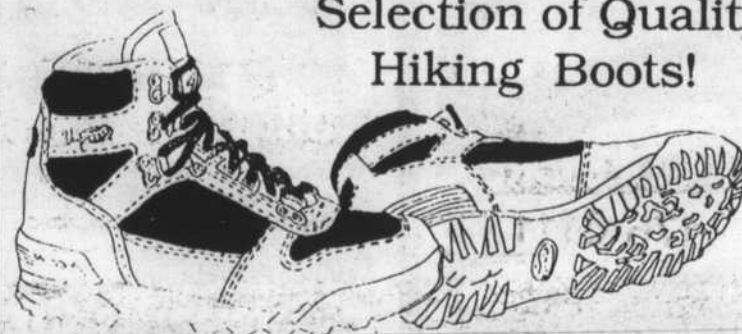

The "upstaged" actor will then be closer to up stage, relative to the ham up front. "Upstage," used as a verb like this, is not a stage direction per se. It is, however, handy theater slang and will convince everyone that you are "in the know."

The Wings: The dark areas to the sides of the stage proper where thugs wait for you to come off stage so they can kill you out of the public eye. A handy way to handle such thugs is to drop sand bags on them.

Fly Space: The area above the stage and out of view of the audience, where Peter Pan hangs out between scenes. Stuff can be lowered from above or "flown" away.

To Go Up: To forget one's lines. The effect on the performer can be

genuinely unnerving. It usually results in several agonizing minutes of babbling before another performer can bail everyone out by skipping to a part everyone knows — like the last scene.

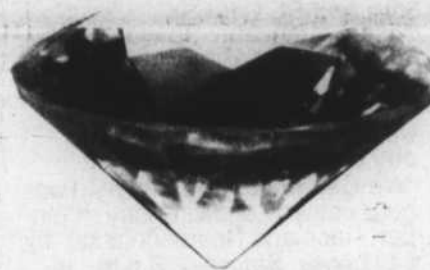
Dear reader,
