# Arizona State athletes suspended for allegedly stealing from stores

TEMPE, Ariz. (AP) — Off-the-field troubles for Arizona State athletes continued Tuesday when starting quarterback Garrick McGee was suspended after a uniformed policeman served him a summons while McGee was attending a class.

Athletic Director Charles Harris also suspended linebacker Tim Smith, although Smith apparently had complied with the orders of a Tempe justice of the peace and resolved the petty theft charge against him.

The announcement came after the court closed for the day and it could not be determined immediately what conditions Smith had to fulfill to satisfy the court.

Both redshirt freshmen allegedly stole goods from two stores close to the campus last October and December.

Clare Lane, McGee's attorney, said he didn't know full details but thought the thefts involved compact discs and T-shirts.

The summons cites three counts of intent to commit theft.

"There are a few bumps in the road, aren't there," first-year coach Bruce Snyder said. He gave former fourth-string quarterback Troy Rauer all the snaps during a two-hour practice Tuesday night.

McGee did not practice. Rauer and backup Brad Belanger, a 5-foot-8-inch, 151-pound freshman, declined to comment.

The Sun Devils open the season here against No. 2 Washington. They play No. 11 Nebraska on Sept. 26.

"He got very, very nervous tonight," Snyder said of Rauer, another redshirt freshman.

Snyder said he suggested the suspension to Harris but added that he believed McGee's story, that the quarterback hadn't heard from the court in seven months and thought the matter had been closed.

Holding out the possibility of reinstatement, Snyder said, "I could do it tonight — if I had all the information."

Snyder said he moved Rauer to outside linebacker last week because he wasn't needed at quarterback.

Grady Benton, who was in contention for the starting quarterback job last spring, and wide receiver Derrick Land are suspended for the game against the Huskies after pleading no contest to fraudulent use of a stolen credit card.

# NCAA suspends Irish linebacker

SOUTH BEND, Ind. (AP) — Notre Dame linebacker Demetrius DuBose was suspended by the NCAA for two games for accepting money from boosters.

Athletic Director Dick Rosenthal said DuBose will miss the season opener Saturday at Northwestern and the Sept. 12 game against Michigan.

The NCAA ruled DuBose's relationship with Grant and Rose Courtney of Seattle violated NCAA rules when he accepted a \$600 personal loan and other benefits from them.

Courtney is president of the Western Washington Notre Dame Alumni Club, and his wife is a former Notre

Dame admissions officer. DuBose grew up in Seattle.

Under NCAA rules, a college athlete loses amateur standing and becomes ineligible if he uses his athletic reputation, skill or payback potential as a professional athlete to obtain preferential treatment, benefits or services.
