She would have been a strong candidate to becoming Nebraska's athletic director when Devaney resigns in January, but she said she didn't want her name thrown into a pool of contenders for a job she knew she'd never get. She said the decision was based primarily on the fact that she doesn't feel Nebraska would hire a woman as AD in the near future.

Hibner has received praise and admiration from her players and coaches alike, and deservedly so, since she has given these people the opportunity to compete at a school now

known for its strong athletic and academic programs for women's sports. But Hibner is the last person to take credit for the success.

"I don't seek recognition," Hibner said. "It's never been my style to compromise teamwork by being caught up in one's self."

From helping get lights on the softball field to getting the women's tennis team the opportunity to compete anywhere throughout the country, Hibner has propelled Nebraska women's athletics to the same level of its male counterparts on the other side of the locker room.
