# Wilhite makes return to practice Thursday

Nebraska football coach Tom Osborne and the Cornhusker defense received a pleasant surprise Thursday as cornerback Kenny Wilhite returned to practice.

Wilhite, a senior, pulled a hamstring during practice Tuesday. Coaches said earlier this week that they did not expect Wilhite to practice or play in Nebraska's second game against Middle Tennessee State Saturday.

Junior strong safety Ernie Beler remained sidelined with a sore ankle, and Osborne said Beler would likely not play Saturday. Beler also missed Nebraska's opener against Utah.

The only other Nebraska injury is to senior strong safety Steve Carmer, who has a sore ankle.

Osborne said he was pleased with the Cornhuskers' health two weeks into the season. Nebraska's only ma-

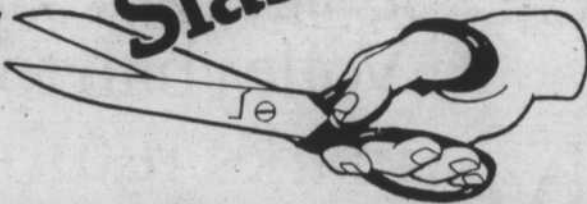
