With a cast of marvelous actors, this powerful and impressive movie touches the issues that were of concern in the 1950s and still today.

Fraser as David, is a far cry from his role in "Encino Man.'

In "School Tics," he plays the serious character of a clean-cut football player, in contrast to a dirty caveman. Fraser managed to play the part of David brilliantly, even shedding tears in some scenes.

Damon ("Mystic Pizza") as Dillon, played a complicated and intricate role of a bigot seeking revenge with the utmost sincerity.

Produced by Sherry Lansing and Stanley R. Jaffe ("Black Rain," "Fa-tal Attraction"), "School Ties" is an extraordinary movie dealing with problems of discrimination, school and parental pressures and economic backgrounds.

Jaffe and Lansing have been interested in doing a film on an exploration of antisemitism since the formation of Jaffe/Lansing Productions nine years


