Editor In Chief

The 1993-94 editor in chief formulates editorial policy, determines guidelines for the daily operation of the newsroom, hires the senior editorial staff, helps determine the content of the editorial page and prepares the editorial salary budget. The position pays \$975/month (except December and May) and reports to the UNL Publications Board. The editor must enroll at UNL for at least six credit hours during each of the two 1993-94 semesters and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.
