Definition: To participate in a variety of responsible and complex administrative, clerical and technical work in support of the public information function; to prepare and provide information for the media and the general public; and to provide responsible administrative support to the City Clerk. Receives general supervision from the City Clerk.

Examples of Duties: (duties may include, but not limited to): Maintain responsibility for all media relations; prepare news releases as appropriate; distribute prepared information and documents to the news media; respond to difficult and sensitive inquiries and questions regarding information distributed. Prepare a regular newsletter for distribution to the citizens of Grand Island; solicit articles and information to include in the newsletter; organize information; prepare and refine the newsletter format; oversee printing and distribution processes. Conduct interviews with City Council members and the Mayor for purposes of public interest; arrange for interviews to be broadcast locally on the radio and television as appropriate. Attend meetings, conferences and seminars regarding the public information function; stay abreast of changes in the administration of the public information function.
