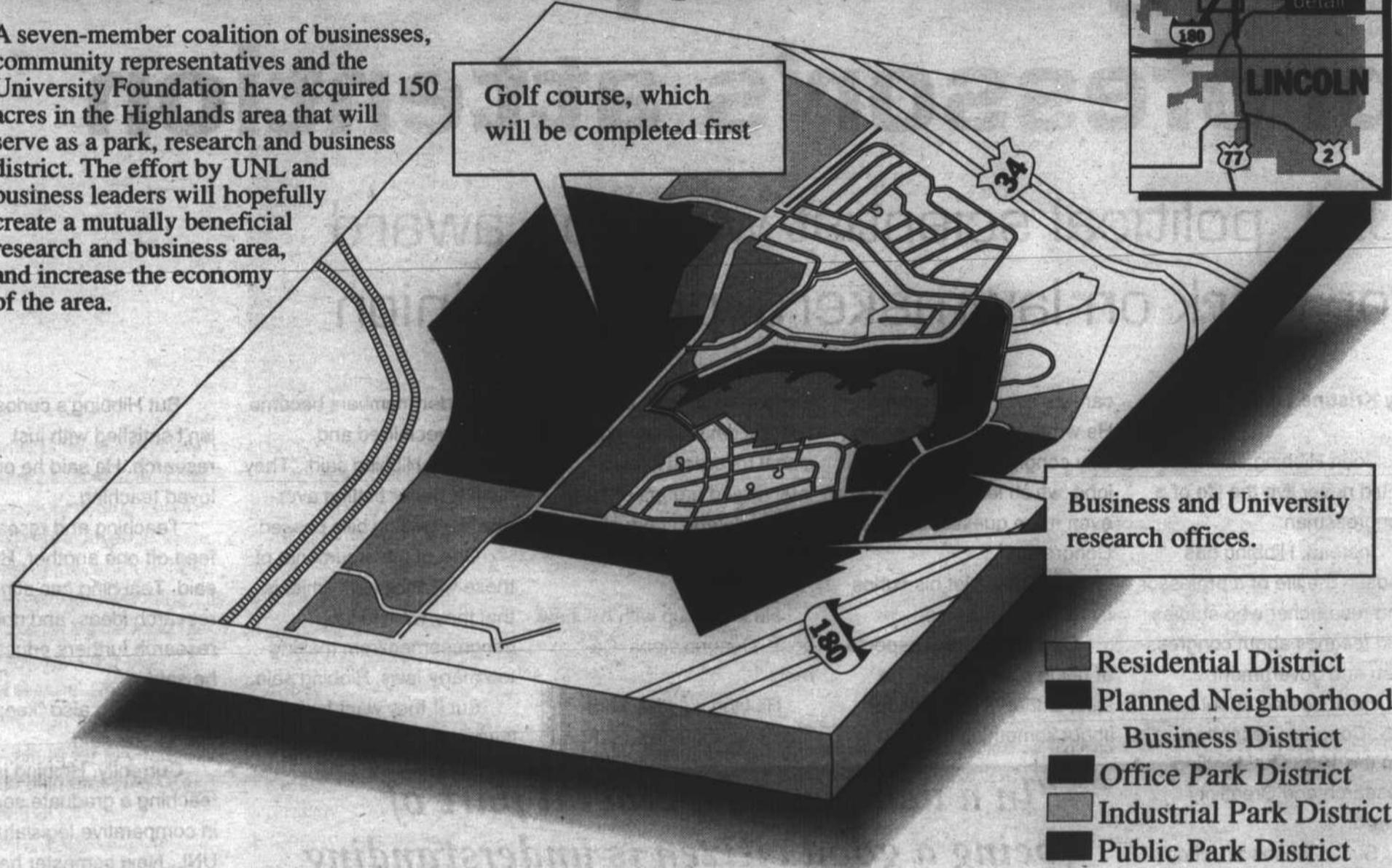


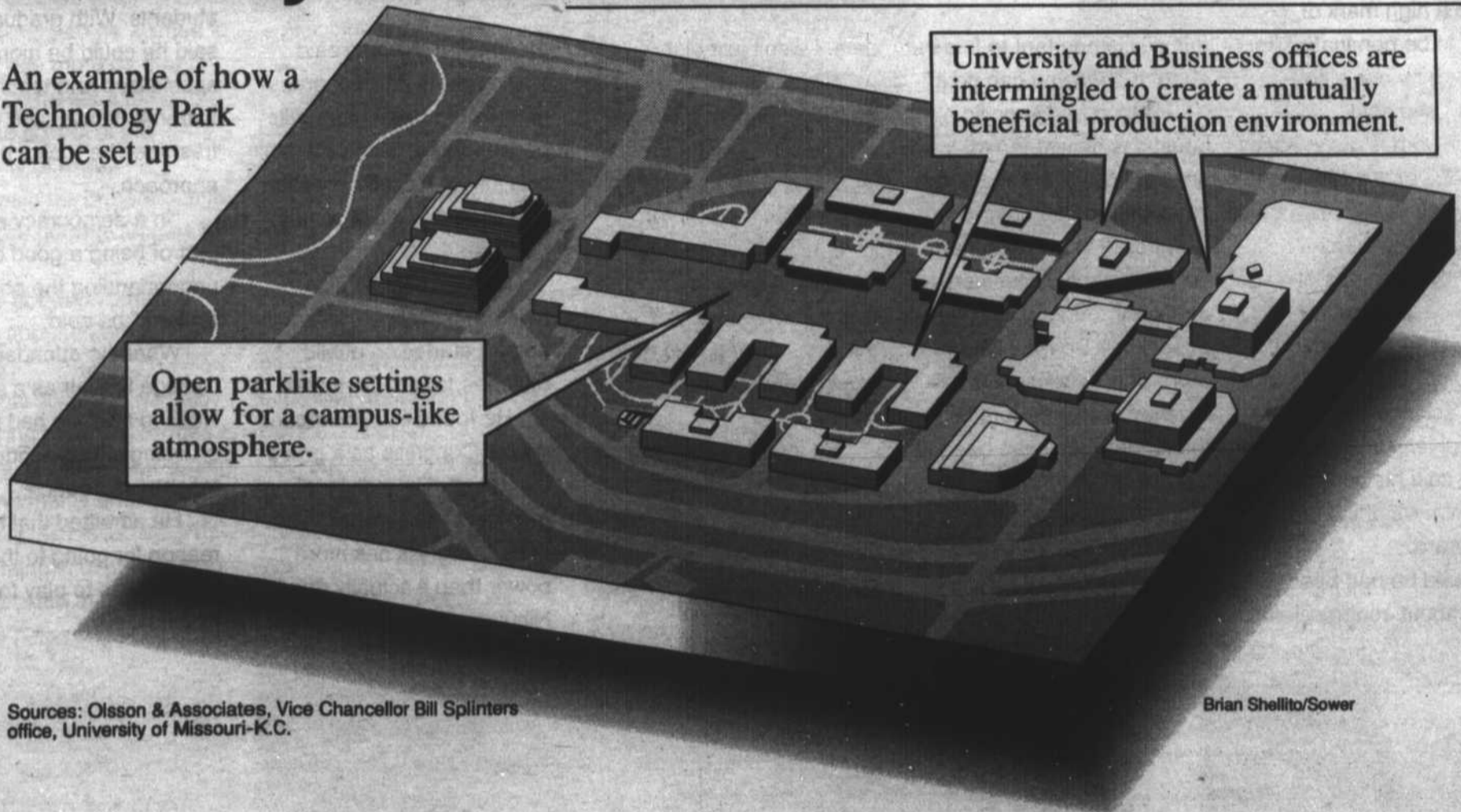
HIGHLAND TECHNOLOGY PARK
