## NU's ten Bensel, men's team outrace the pack in Minnesota

Fran ten Bensel set a meet record in the 1,500-meter run Saturday at the Gopher Invitational in Minneapolis.

Ten Bensel's time of 4 minutes, 16.42 seconds was the third-fastest time in school history and it automatically qualified her for the NCAA competition.

Paulette Mitchell broke her own school record in the shot put with a throw of 52-feet, 6 and 3/4 inches.

On the men's side, Robert Thomas won two events to lead Nebraska to a victory over Minnesota and Kansas.

Thomas won the long jump and the triple jump. His triple jump of 51 feet, 5 and 3/4 inches was an NCAA provisional qualifying mark.

Nebraska's Andy Meyer also had an NCAA-provisional mark in the discus with his throw of 187 feet, 11-inches.

On the women's side, NU's Destiny Liebl posted an NCAA qualifying mark in the high jump with a leap of six feet.

Other event winners for the men included Travis Grant in the 200-meter dash, David Iteffa in the 5,000-meter run, Willie Hibler in the 110-meter hurdles and Petar Malesav in the high jump with a leap of 7 feet and 1/4 inches.

The men's 4 X 100 meter relay team of Travis Grant, Isaac Carson, Tyrone Hughes and Thomas won the 400-meter relay.

The men's 1600-meter relay team also won.

For the women, Kwani Stewart won the long jump and the 100-meter hurdles, Nicola Martial won the triple jump. The 400-meter relay team of Tranquil Wilson, Stewart, Janna Hammon and Jenny Johnson also won.

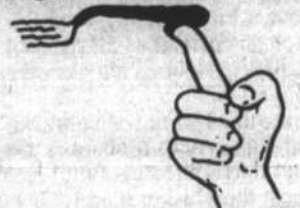
