After cries of, "An acre of hemp produces four times as much paper as an acre of trees," the listener hears a blast of gurgling water.

B-Real explains, "there's water inside, don't spill it / it smells like shit on the carpet / still goes down smooth when I get a clean hit." And when the bowl is cashed, via audio, the bong water is heard once again to end the song.

The entire album is strong, and believe it or not, it is not entirely centered on cannabis. Muggs' trademark horn and siren blasts are practically the staples of both of the group's endeavors, as well as Muggs' other productions for House of Pain, Funkdoobiest and Ice Cube. Muggs is a producer extraordinaire.

Some of the harder tracks include "When the Shit Goes Down" and "I Ain't Going Out Like That," which are up-tempo, as well as "A to the K," a tribute to the group's favorite gun.

While Cypress Hill does explore violence in its songs, in the end it is obvious the group is much more concerned about "high" times and music than in killings. Cypress Hill's real talent is getting the listeners high, no illegal substances necessary.
