

## Missouri group wants to say bye to Big 8

A Missouri athletic booster group may be looking to turn the Big Eight into the Big Seven and the Big Ten into the Big Twelve.

"MU—A National Asset," a booster group, was formed earlier this summer to demonstrate to the Big Ten Conference that Missouri was academically solid enough to join the Big Ten.

Big Eight football coaches responded to the news with less than favorable opinions during the weekly Big Eight coaches teleconference on Monday.

Nebraska coach Tom Osborne said he was disturbed by Missouri's action.

Iowa State coach Jim Walden was not as kind as Osborne.

"I don't like reading where a member of my family says he likes another family better than he does mine," Walden said. "I take it a little personally, if you want to know the truth."

"Don't come into my house to eat and go outside and tell me what a terrible cook I am."

Missouri coach Bob Stull defended Missouri's actions and said the Tigers were content with the Big Eight.

"We're part of the Big Eight Conference, and a very proud member," Stull said. "As far as I'm concerned, that's all there is to it."

"If the league were to dissolve for whatever reason, then I think the Big Ten would be a good direction for us to go."

blocker, recorded a career-high 28 kills, and sophomore outside hitter Billie Winsett also had a career-high 22 kills. Stricker had a team-high 69 set assists, two short of her career-high.

On Friday, the Huskers began the tournament with a three-game sweep over West Virginia, 15-11, 15-6, 15-0.

Noth said junior outside hitter Kelly Aspegren and freshman middle blocker Jen McFadden continued to

play well during the invitational.

Aspegren, who played sparingly last year, had seven kills. McFadden added a team-high eight.

"Kelly Aspegren had a good match against West Virginia, and the Penn State match was a good test for Kelly," Noth said. "She held her own against Penn State, even though her hitting percentage was down a little."

"Jen McFadden played well, too. She's a great freshman player."

The Huskers defeated Pittsburgh 15-8, 15-10, 11-15, 15-9 on Saturday. The Lady Panthers have never defeated Nebraska in 10 matches.
