Frazier's ankle still on the mend

Nebraska football coach Tom Osborne said Wednesday that quarterback Tommie Frazier was continuing to show signs of improvement from the ankle sprain he suffered against North Texas.

"Frazier moved about the best he has on a Wednesday since he got hurt," Osborne said. "He's still not 100 percent, but he appeared to be a

little better."

Wingback Abdul Muhammad, who has a sore knee and ankle, practiced on Wednesday but is questionable for Saturday, Osborne said. Outside linebacker Bruce Moore, who has a pulled groin, did not practice and is doubtful for Colorado State, Osborne said.

Right tackle Zach Wiegert (knee and ankle) practiced and is listed as probable for this week.

The Huskers, who normally practice on the grass fields on Wednesdays, worked out at Memorial Stadium because of the wet conditions.

"I think we had a good practice," Osborne said. "We did back off a little bit. Last night I was a little worried because we banged around a lot on Monday and Tuesday. So we did ease off and hopefully they'll be in a little better shape by Saturday."

University Health Center GM-Southwest Student Insurance

The Student Insurance program is open to both graduate and under-graduate students. It was designed to work together with the Health Center to help off-set the high cost of medical care.

There are some changes this year in the procedure for enrollment that will be affecting International Students. Immigration laws state that non-resident students must be financially responsible to reside in this country. The UNL policy requires mandatory insurance for International Students. These students are required to show proof of private coverage or be billed automatically on their tuition statements for Student Insurance.

The coverage dates for International Students is 8/12/93 thru 8/11/94. The premium of \$211.00 per semester will be on your tuition statement.

Enrollment is open for Domestic students and ALL dependents until 9/23/93. If you have not enrolled in the Student Insurance program by then, you must wait until Spring Semester begins 1/9/94.
