"If we were to back down due to alumni pressure, it would set a bad precedent."

The event has received more than a fair share of media attention. When UPC was first bandying the event idea around, USA Today picked the story up and ran it. From there, a media blitz occurred. The television tabloid show "Hard Copy" plans on attending and filming Barney Day.

Fox has done phone interviews for radio stations across the country, been interviewed by countless reporters, and was flown to Chicago on Monday for a taping of the Jerry Springer show.

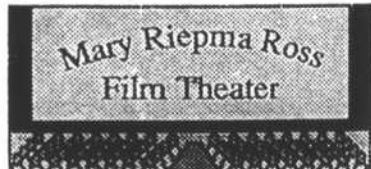

# Video artist to show work at UNL

## Ross theater screens works



Doris Chase is something of a renaissance woman.

"I started in painting and then moved to sculpture and then to dance and dance with sculpture," she said in a telephone interview from her home in New York's famous Chelsea Hotel.

"It's all just a development from one to the next to the next," she said.

"People think it's just like a bolt of lightning, but it's not," she said, of switching from one art form to another.

"One thing just develops into another."

Her work in electronic media, specifically video, has been ground breaking and influential.

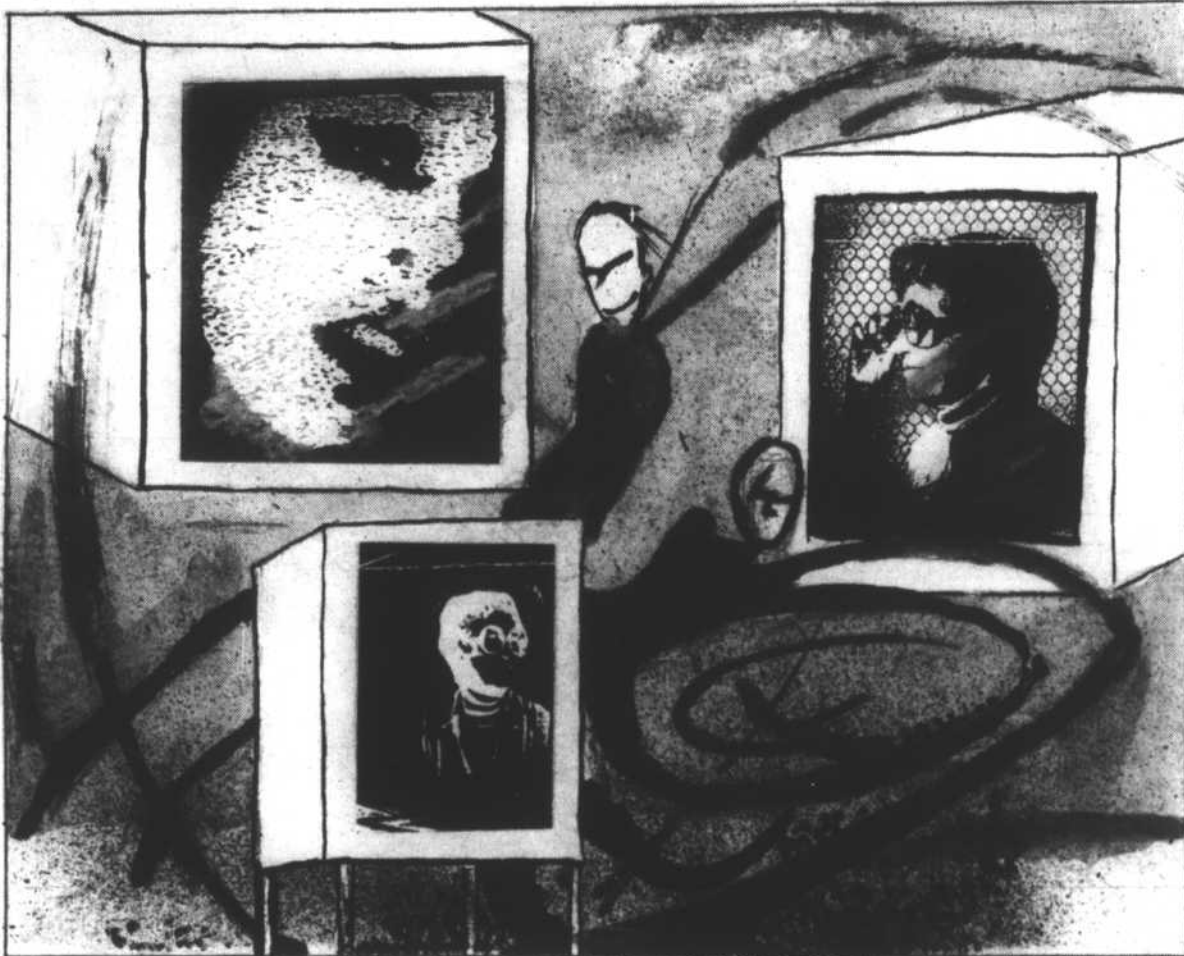
Effects she pioneered in the mid 1970s would later appear in some of MTV's earliest videos.

This weekend the Mary Riepma Ross Film Theatre plays host to a smorgasbord of Chase's video work, as well as to the artist herself.

She will appear at Saturday's and Sunday's 7:30 p.m. viewing of her films to answer questions from the audience and talk about her work.

Her work, on video at least, falls into several broad categories and covers several of her previous artistic interests:

- The "By Herself" series, five

films telling the story of the lives of five different women's lives.

- The "Concept" series — less narrative collaborations with eight different women artists.

- The "Dance" series, of which there are quite a few.

Many of these make use of special effects. They are abstract video poems that combine a number of video techniques with music and dance.

There are also a series of "Video Sculpture" pieces that combine Chase's sculpture with special effects.

Also featured will be Chase's most recent production, which is something of a departure for her.

It's a documentary about the building she's made her home for twenty years — The Chelsea Hotel.

The Chelsea has a long history as the home of artists and creative people from around the world.

Its lively atmosphere and eccentric inhabitants make this a fascinating look into the private lives — sometimes petty, sometimes illuminating — of some of New York's creative elite.
