Piatkowski picked for All-Star Game

Nebraska's Eric Piatkowski has been chosen as one of 20 seniors to play in the NABC College All-Star Game Sunday at 2 p.m. at Independence Arena in Charlotte, N.C.

Piatkowski, a 6-foot-7-inch, 215-pound guard from Rapid City, S.D., will play on the East team, which will be coached by Winston-Salem State coach Clarence "Bighouse" Gaines.

Piatkowski — who averaged 21.5 points and 6.3 rebounds per game this season and is the second

leading scorer in Cornhusker history — is the second leading scorer on the East team behind Jerv Vaughn Scales of Southern.

The game, which is part of the Final Four festivities, will be preceded by a slam dunk and three-point challenge.

Piatkowski is the third Nebraska player ever to play in the NABC game. Rich King played in 1991 and Chuck Jura in 1972.

Jeff Webster of Oklahoma was the only other Big Eight player selected.

Men's golf finishes fourth in Missouri

The Nebraska men's golf team completed its most successful tournament of the season Tuesday by firing a third-round score of 309 to finish in fourth place at the Southwest Missouri State's Golf Invitational in Springfield, Mo.

The Cornhuskers shot a three-round total of 932.

The Huskers, who were tied for

first place after the second round of the tournament on Monday, finished seven shots behind champion North Texas, which fired a three-day total of 925.

Nebraska freshman Trent Morrison shot a three-round total of 226 to finish in fifth place. Senior Chad Dubisar fired a 78 in the third round to finish in 11th place with a score of 231.

Senior Frank Velazquez, an All-American last year, was eliminated from the NCAA meet after losing his first match. Sixth-seed Justin Ware was also upset in the first round.


"Once you get to nationals, everybody's on their own," he said. "You have to spend so much time preparing for your match, and you can't dwell on what happened to your buddies."
