Court denies Woody Allen's custody appeal

ALBANY, N.Y. (AP) - New York state's top court rejected an appeal of a ruling awarding cus-tody of Woody Allen's three children to Mia Farrow.

A judge last year gave Farrow custody of the couple's two adopted children, Dylan and Moses, and their biological son, Satchel.

Allen contended on appeal that the custody decision was meant to punish him for his affair with Farrow's adopted daughter, Soon-Yi Previn.

On Tuesday, the Court of Appeals dismissed the case on the grounds that the matter is not fi-

Allen's lawyer, Elkan Abramowitz, said that was because the lower court ordered that Allen pay Farrow's legal fees and the fees have not yet been set.

Martin Ciccone, 37, was arrested July 9 after a traffic accident.

"As far as we know, he doesn't have the money," said Michael Salhaney, an assistant Oakland County prosecutor.

Madonna's spokeswoman, Liz Rosenberg, said the star had no comment. "It's personal. It's family," Rosenberg said.
