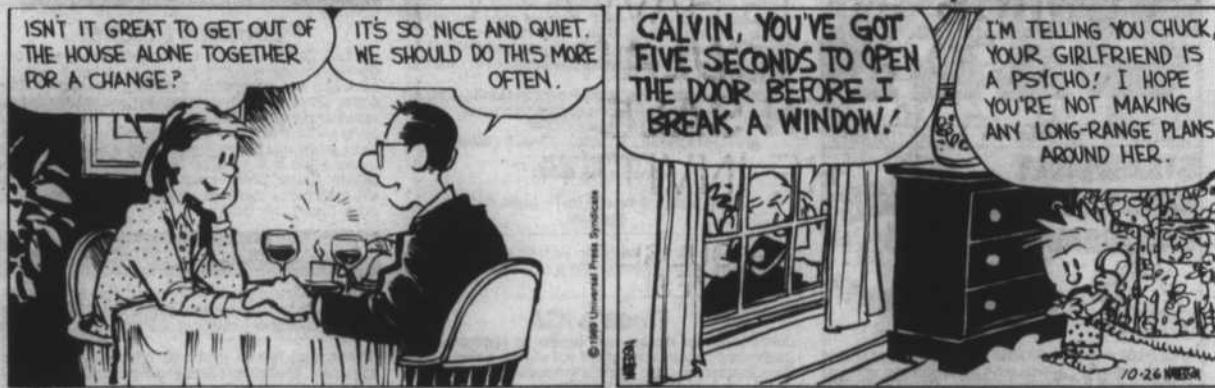

Crossword

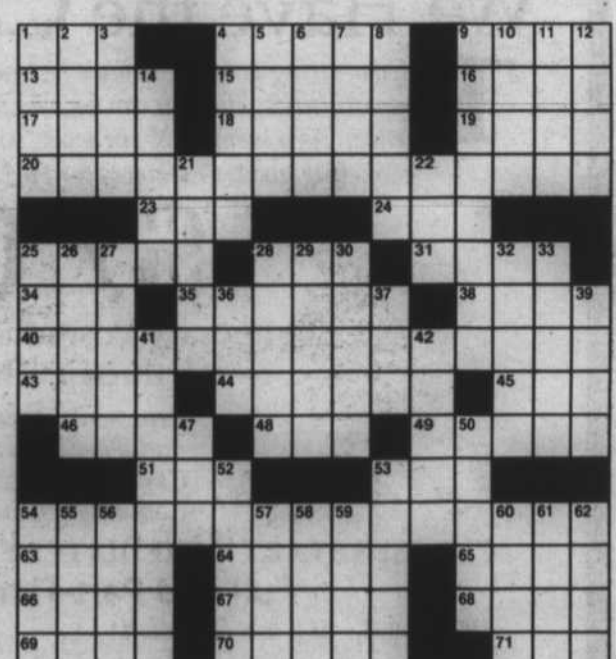
