

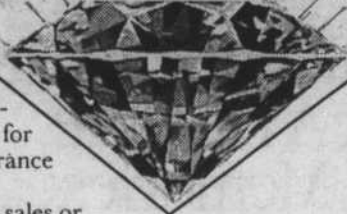

relationship to talk to their next-highest supervisor to guarantee that the relationship was consensual. However, she said no recognition was given to the possibility that a person may use their position's power to get that consent.

Jane Close Conoley, chairwoman of the UNL educational psychology department and a member of the Chancellor's Commission on the Status of Women, agreed and said she had experience in faculty relations. She said her husband, Collie, was a

faculty member in the Teachers College.

Conoley said when it came to dealing with her husband administratively, she passed the responsibility on because love and work formed a conflict of interest.

"Those two things can't go together," she said. "I think it should be mandatory that if I am in a sexual relationship with that person, I must excuse myself from direct supervision."

"The document says it is a very bad idea for supervisors to get involved with the supervisees, but the document doesn't have much teeth to that."

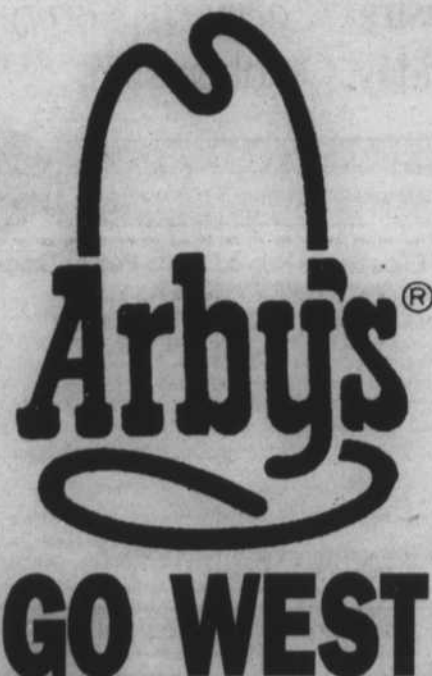
