

Turman throws 1st time since injuring shoulder

Nebraska practiced for two hours Wednesday at Memorial Stadium in preparation for Saturday's showdown with Colorado.

No. 2 I-back Damon Benning missed practice with a sore ankle but is expected to return to practice today.

Quarterback Matt Turman, who suffered a bruised shoulder last Saturday against Missouri, threw for the first time since the injury.

"Matt Turman threw the ball a little bit today," Coach Tom Osborne said. "He didn't throw very deep, and

he didn't throw very hard, but it looks like he might at least be available to play Saturday."


