CFA rejects health center request

The Committee for Fees Allocation denied the University Health Center's request for a 2.23 percent budget increase Thursday night.

Instead, the committee voted to recommend a .5 percent increase to pay for higher telecommunication

Members of CFA's health center subcommittee said the center could streamline operations to cover its requested in-

ing revenue sources and decreasing funding for outreach programs such as the health aide program, peer alcohol educators and peer sexuality edu-

The subcommittee also recommended that the health center cease keeping an orderly on duty between p.m. and 7 a.m.
