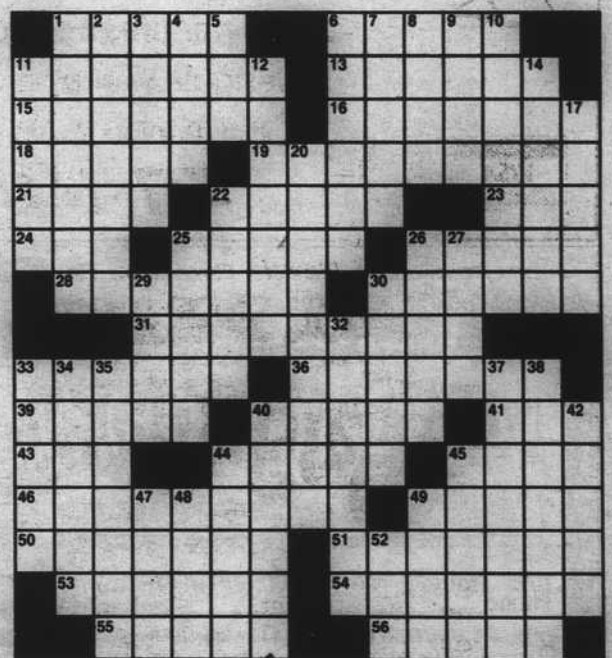

Editor In Chief

The 1995-96 editor formulates editorial policy, determines guidelines for the daily operation of the newsroom, hires the senior editorial staff, helps determine the content of the editorial page and prepares the editorial salary budget.

Applicants must have one year of newspaper experience, preferably at the Daily Nebraskan, enrolled at UNL for at least six credit hours during the two 95-96 semesters, maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and submit clips when applying. Salary is \$975/month (except December and May, 1996) starting Aug. 1, 1995 (with 1/2 month in April, 1995). Applications are available in the Daily Nebraskan office, 34 Nebraska Union, and must be returned by 3 p.m., Feb. 10.
