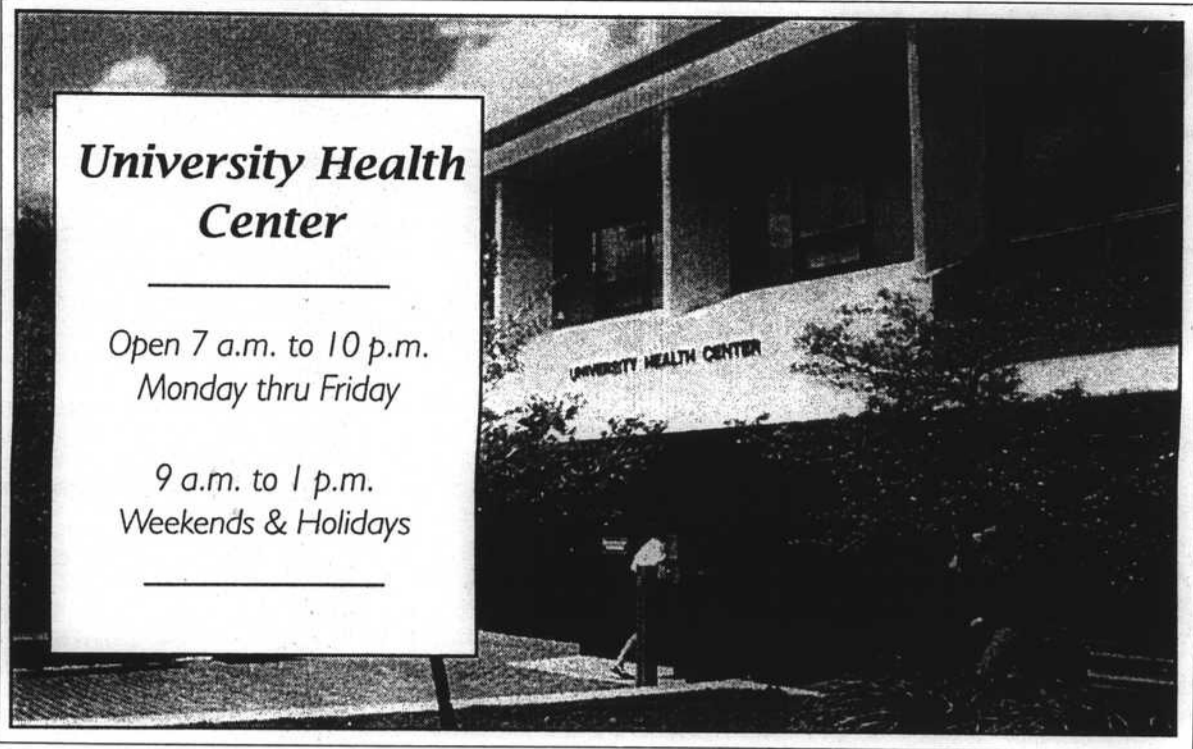
Jaron Boone, a junior guard on the Nebraska men's basketball team, has been named the winner of the Jack Moore Award, given to the team's most outstanding player.

Benning said he knew what to expect from last year's offensive line, which was considered by many as Nebraska's best ever.

"You know how a guy is going to come out and pull or something," he said. "A lot of guys have their own style. We were accustomed to dealing with those guys last year.

"They'd hold their blocks for a while and lay on people a while. We had time to make reads."

Benning returns after rushing for 367 yards and scoring five touchdowns in 1994.

"We just have to make sure we do our job in holding onto the ball," Benning said, "and hitting the holes when they're there. That's what it's all about — us taking care of our business."

For that to happen, the I-backs — Phillips, James Sims and Brian Knuckles — need to start practicing again, Benning said.

"You just want to get out there and be a person to make a difference.
