

This semester, Junior Chris Bell took a defunct campus organiza-

tion and gave it new life. The University of Nebraska-Lincoln Future Filmmakers and Screenwriters was inactive for more than a year, Bell said, until he realized that aspiring directors and writers needed a forum to meet and discuss

"Through talking with people, there seems to be a real interest in film production," Bell said, "but there is no place to congregate."

After learning there was such an organization at one time and that it had been abandoned, Bell took the initiative to revamp the club and appeal to new members.

To attract new members, the Future Filmmakers and Screenwriters will have a free screening of "Raising Arizona" in the Nebraska Union Wednesday at 7 p.m.

"We wanted to create an informal setting where we could get to know people interested in the club and show them what we're about," Bell said. "So we picked a movie that everyone is bound to like. We wanted to get to know each other in

a film setting. The club has no membership fees and anyone is welcome to the free screening. Bell said the club had two main goals: to share ideas and to find equipment and talent to realize those ideas. A major function of the club is to network and to see what others are doing in the film medium, he said.

"Before the screening we'll be showing the pilot to MTV's 'The State,' directed by a member of our organization," Bell said.

"We go out and look for things to write about," she said. "We don't sit around and wait for ideas to pop into our heads.


