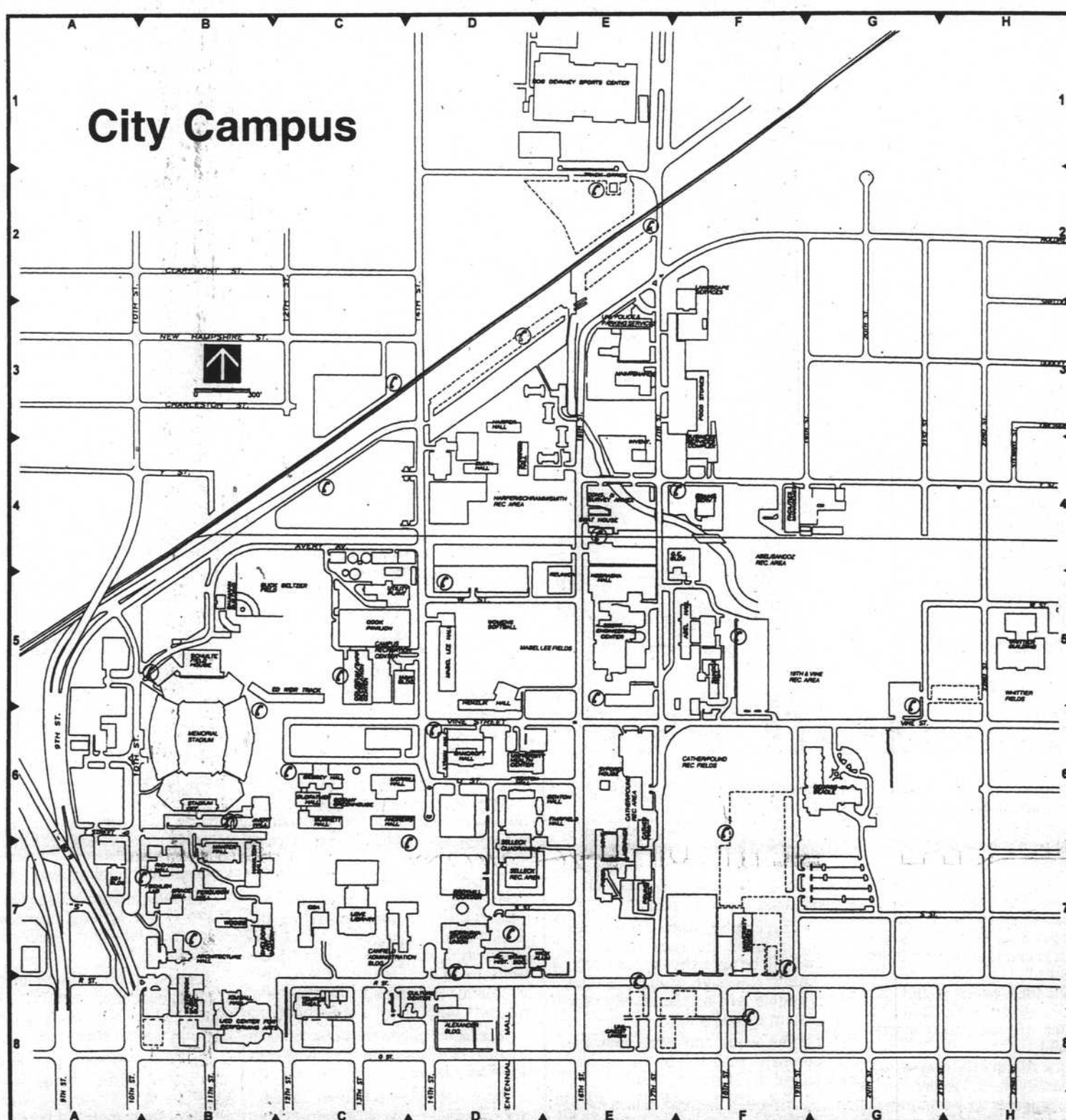

whole portions.

Choose from international pastas such as Peking peanut penne, Euro pasta (chicken, mushrooms, walnuts and artichoke hearts) or a vegetarian pasta.

Classic pastas consist of fettucine and linguine dishes. Fettucine Jabrisco is especially tasty.

Wood-fired pizzas are another Jabrisco specialty, including a vegetarian feast pizza, potato pizza, a Mexican pizza and even a barbecue chicken pizza.

Jabrisco also serves mammoth cappuccinos, a perfect end to any meal. Lazlo's Brewery and Grill (710 P Street): Spacious with inviting atmosphere, Lazlo's is a popular restaurant among college students.

Lazlo's also offers a variety of appetizers, salads, burgers and sandwiches.

Especially tasty appetizers include beer batter onion rings, gargantuan yellow onion rings dipped in seasoned batter.

Salads are huge, served with a toasted, buttered slice of fresh-baked beer bread.

Cobb salad (fresh greens topped with hickory-grilled breast of chicken, artichoke hearts, Monterey Jack, cheddar, croutons and more!) is highly recommended with Lazlo's creamy honey mustard dressing.

Burgers and sandwiches are served with either homemade applesauce, french fries, cole slaw or honey-glazed baked beans.

The Lazlo burger, the albacore tuna melt, the classic reuben and the barbecue chicken grill are all recommended.

Rainbow chicken, hickory-grilled chicken breast topped with melted Monterey Jack, shredded cheddar, tomatoes and onions, is always worth the price.

Lazlo's is the oldest brewery in Nebraska and those 21 and older can choose from a variety of hand-crafted beers made fresh daily.

Vincenzo's Ristorante (808 P Street): Vincenzo's is authentic Italian dining; a bit pricey, but well worth a few extra bucks.

Walking into Vincenzo's is like entering an extraordinarily large studio apartment. The restaurant is long, almost hallway-like. Black-and-white photographs decorate the walls.

The menu includes appetizers, salads, pastas, seafood, baked specials and veal and chicken entrees.

Goodi rooni (a broccoli, potato and provol stuffing in a homemade double crust) is one of the more unique Vincenzo's appetizers.

So is melanzane, fresh eggplant slices baked with marinara sauce.

Patrons can choose from a St. Louis-style pizza selection, all extremely well-priced as are the salads.

Pastas, seafood and baked specials are served with a house salad and bread.

Tortellini Bianco, pasta primavera and Dorene's baked lasagna are all worth trying.

Veal and chicken entrees come with a house salad, daily vegetable and potato.

Eating at Vincenzo's requires saving extra pennies, but is quite a fine dining experience.

Naturally, this isn't the limit of restaurants available to the students of UNL, but just a sampler of something to sink your teeth into.

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
