## Nebraska swimmer loses toe in accident

Teresa Mauck was biking to swim practice Wednesday afternoon when an accident with a university shuttle bus resulted in the loss of her left toe.

Lincoln police reports gave the following account of the incident.

A university shuttle bus was making a right turn out of a remote parking lot on to Court Street between 15th and 16th streets.

Mauck was riding west down Court Street when she tried to stop in front of the bus, using her brakes and feet.

The driver of the bus said he didn't see her right away because she was in his blind spot. He tried to stop, but couldn't avoid the collision.

The front tire of the bus ran over her left foot, severing her big toe.

Mauck, a freshman from San Clemente, Calif., was taken to Lincoln General Hospital where she underwent surgery.


The Nebraska swimmer said from her hospital room that doctors told her she would be able to walk in two weeks and may be able to swim again in a month or two.


Mauck said her mother arrived in Lincoln early this morning.


