"Nothing like this ever happens around here."

Jennifer Jett, 38, appeared in "To Wong Foo" as an extra and said the production went very well.

Jett even had the chance to meet and talk with Swayze, one of the stars of the film.

"He is an excellent performer," Jett said. "He was very personable and professional."

Beeban Kidron, director of "To Wong Foo," said she was happy to see familiar faces once again.

"It's wonderful to see all these recognizable faces," Kidron said. "These people were my family while we were filming here."

Speaking to the audience before the show, Kidron addressed how both the film itself and the making of the film helped deal with stereotypes.

"Just as many people have preconceived notions about drag queens," Kidron said. "We had preconceived notions about people from Nebraska.

"While filming, our notions were turned around by the embracing and kindness we received from everybody we met. This premiere is our way to say 'Thank you' to all of the

people here in Nebraska who helped make this film come together."
