The American Boychoir "Hymn" Sparrow Grade: C

With only a few exceptions, "Hymn" is a somewhat monotonous choral album with little variety, enriched only slightly by guest vocalists and unusual arrangements.

While most people would recognize the traditional music, this CD is primarily for the classical music lover.

The American Boychoir, of Princeton, N.J., comprises 80 boys ages 10 to 14. Directed by Dr. James Litton, the choir combines its efforts with the Albemarle Consort of Voices and the St. Luke's Chamber Ensemble. Twila Paris and Steven Curtis Chapman are also featured on the album.

Despite the lack of variety and the predictability of some songs, "Hymn" is, overall, a worthwhile listening experience.

Only the first hymn holds to a strict, straight-toned, a cappella chordal boychoir sound. The other songs are enriched with orchestration and adult male voices, giving the sound warmth and richness. Each track brings new variation to otherwise old, over-sung hymns. The combination of the choir

with Paris and Chapman works but not very well. Chapman and his guitar add little to the music the choir and orchestral ensemble have already established on "Amazing Grace." The arrangement makes this combination possible, but, if anything, the sound is cheapened by the addition of Chapman.

Chapman and the choir don't give energy to one another. The same is true on "Spirit of the Living God," which also features

Most of the hymns on this album are fulfilling, ranging from "Christe, qui lux es et Dies," a medieval chant-hymn, to the more contemporary sound of "Morning Has Broken," made popular by Cat Stevens.


The wonderful relationship between instrumentation and vocals is perhaps the highlight of the album.

The only exception to this is the last track, "The Old 100th." This song uses all the voices of The American Boychoir, The Albemarle Consort of Voices, the St. Luke's Chamber Ensemble — with high-lights on its brass section — and a pipe organ.

The attempt was to get a full, majestic sound. This is probably very effective in a live setting, but on a recording, it leaves something to be desired.

"Hymn" is not a bad album to add to one's classical library. But for those not accustomed to this type of music, be aware: It falls short of capturing the true beauty of the hymn.




