Host tells all in future book

MINNEAPOLIS (AP)-Radio talk-show host Barbara Carlson has embarrassed her ex-husband, Minnesota Gov. Arne Carlson, before by talking about their failed marriage on the air.

Now she's planning a tell-all book, and the governor is warning that he won't tolerate any "defamatory material."
