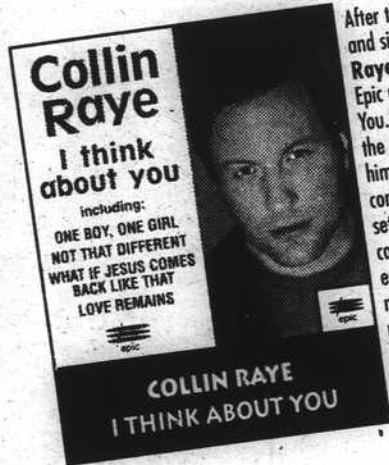

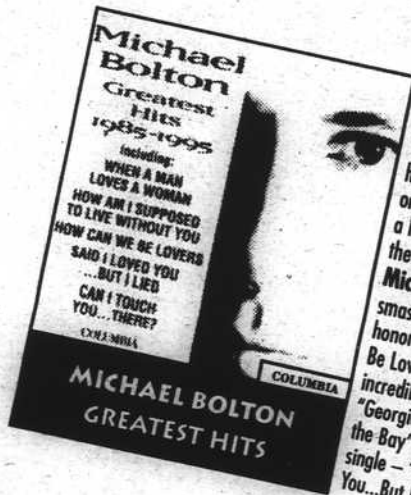
After three platinum albums and six #1 singles, Collin Raye returns with his fourth Epic release, "I Think About You." The new album develops the elements that have made him one of country's most consistent artists: ballads that set the standard of what one can expect from a song emotionally; tempo songs that make any day a Saturday night; and message songs that show how much more there is beneath the surface of the people we encounter.



The Red Hot Chili Peppers roar back to the multiplatinum "Blood Sugar Sex Magik." Teaming once again with producer Rick Rubin, they've crafted their wildest, funkier, most aggressively rockin' albums to date. With new lead guitarist David Navarro (formerly of Jane's Addiction) lending his indelible touch to the proceedings, "One Hot Minute" is the band's finest hour and is destined to be one of the biggest records of the year.



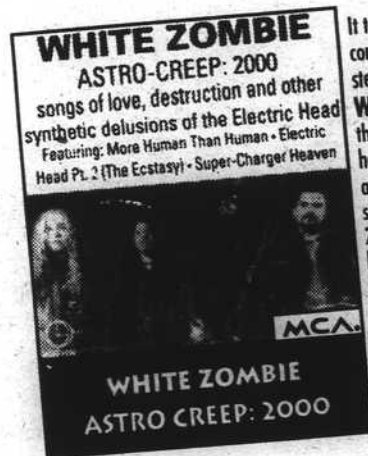
From 50's surf classics to 70's funk, the album includes performances by the likes of Urge Overkill, Al Green, Ricky Nelson, Kool & The Gang and Maria McKee. Perhaps the choicest bits are guitar-based instrumentals from The Centurions, The Revels, The Lively Ones, The Tornadoes and Dick Dale & His Del-tones.



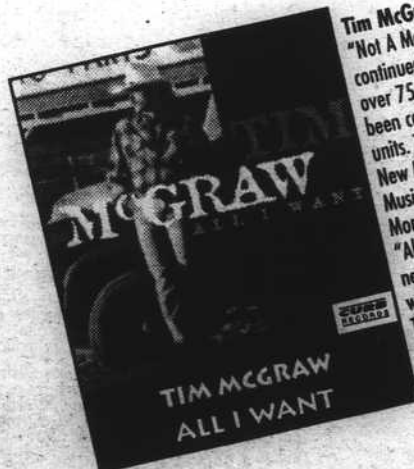
"Michael Bolton's Greatest Hits 1985-1995" is a true greatest hits collection. Each song on this release has been a hit - on radio and on the charts. Thirteen Michael Bolton smashes - from the time honored "How Can We Be Lovers" to the incredible renditions of "Georgia" and "Dock of the Bay" to his biggest single - "Said I Loved You...But I Lied."



Over the past few years, Travis Tritt has established himself as one of Nashville's biggest talents of the 90's. This anthology contains 13 of his biggest hits along with two new tracks. Included here is the recent no. 1 hit "Tell Me I Was Dreaming," as well as smash singles from throughout Travis's career, including "Anymore," "Country Club," "Here's A Quarter (Call Someone Who Cares)" and nine more, virtually all of them top five hits.



It took nearly two years of constant touring and steadily rising sales, but White Zombie proved to the industry what their fans had known all along...this is a band to be taken seriously. Now, White Zombie unearth a new beast, "Astro Creep: 2000" songs of love, destruction and other synthetic delusions of the Electric Head produced by both the band and Terry Date (Pantera, Soundgarden).



Tim McGraw's second album, "Not A Moment To Soon" has continued to top the charts for over 75 weeks. The album has just been certified at over 5,000,000 units. Tim has been voted "Best New Male Artist" by the Academy of Music Association and "Not A Moment To Soon" received the "Album Of The Year" award. Tim's new album "All I Want", is packed with twelve songs that should hold Tim at the top of the charts throughout the 1995 fall selling season and beyond.
