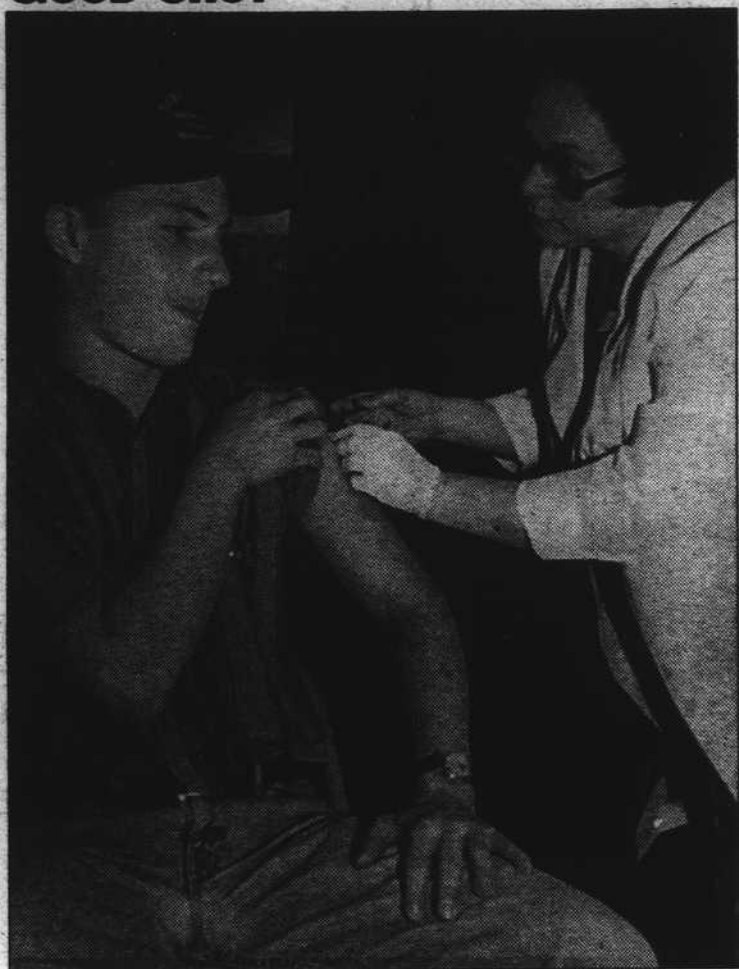

New program allows students to share skills

A new Student Involvement program will allow students to help each other by sharing skills and experiences.

Kim Hobson, a student organization consultant with the Student Involvement office, said the program, called "This 'n That," will use students' expertise in certain areas to benefit fellow students.

The center was built in the early 1980s, and the water heater has needed frequent repairs lately, said Marlyn Logan, the center's program director. A new water heater will cost about \$5,000.

The center was founded in 1932 to provide human services to Lincoln residents of all social, economic and educational levels. It is funded by grants and contributions.

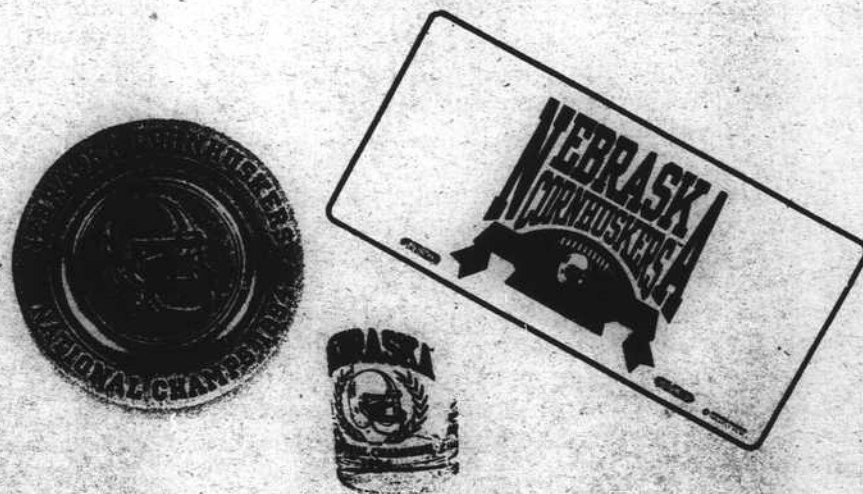
