NEW YORK (AP) - Robert De Niro faces charges of being a raging bully.

Joseph Ligier contends the star of "Raging Bull" gave him a bloody nose outside a downtown club early Saturday when he refused to turn over some video he was shooting of the actor.

De Niro surrendered to police after the encounter and was fingerprinted, booked and released on the misdemeanor.

'He punched me in the nose and grabbed me by my hair," Ligier told the Daily News. "He had me bent over a car. He kept saying, 'Give me the video.' I said, 'No way.' I had footage of Julia Roberts on the same tape.

Finally, Ligier said, "He let go and threw the camera's eyepiece and filter at me."

De Niro spokesman Stan

Rosenfield said Ligier was part of a new breed of "video paparazzi" who provoke celebrities into scenes, then sell the footage

Ligier said he had a deal to sell the tape to "Hard Copy," but a spokesman for the program, Gary Rosen, said Ligier wasn't on assignment for the show.
