Who knows? But an East Campus researcher can tell you what comes

next: the Omega egg. This egg — developed by Sheila Sheideler, a poultry scientist — contains more omega-3 fatty acids, which may boost the ratio of good to bad cholesterol and reduce the occurrence of blood clots.

This, in turn, reduces the risk of cardiovascular disease, Sheideler said. NU athletes have been eating the

eggs since September, when the eggs made their debut at the Training Table, a special food service for athletes.

The Training Table also offers outof-season fresh produce, reduced fat and calorie meats, and special vegetarian meals, said David Ellis, coordinator of performance nutrition. Ellis said he was excited about the

egg's increased nutritional value. "We're always looking for avenues and vehicles to increase the omega-3 complex in our athlete's diets," he




