# Husker wrestlers to compete in Vegas

The No. 2 ranked Nebraska wrestling team will be one of eight teams ranked in the top 25 competing this Friday and Saturday in the Las Vegas Invitational.

Cornhusker coach Tim Neumann said the meet would be a good first-semester test for the team.

"We're probably only at 60 percent of what we'll be come March," Neumann said. "It would be good to win this early in the season."

Neumann said three Husker wrestlers would be competing in a weight class higher than where they will be later in the season.

"I'm not sure that anybody has all of their guys down at their best fighting weight," Neumann said.

No. 3 Oklahoma State, No. 4 Arizona State, No. 5 Iowa State and

No. 6 Oregon State are among the other top teams competing this weekend in Las Vegas.

"For us to win, we're probably going to have to have at least eight of our 10 wrestlers place," Neumann said. "And we'll need to push four into the finals."

Neumann said Husker wrestlers Tony DeAnda, Jason Kraft, Ryan Tobin and Tolly Thompson would be Nebraska's best shot at making the finals.

Thompson, last year's defending NCAA heavyweight champion, is currently ranked No. 1 in his weight class.

Neumann said he expected Thompson and Tobin to continue their winning ways.

"We're all going in on an even playing field," Neumann said. "If we don't win, it's not the end of the season. We'll just see where everybody stacks up at this time of the year."

The winners will play at 8 p.m., Saturday in the championship.

"Basically, we built our season around what we're going to face the next couple of weeks," Beck said. "The Oregon State Classic is going to be a real challenge for us. Our No. 1 thing we really want to do is try to focus on the first game."

Beck said 3-1 Montana State is an improved team with four players averaging more than 10 points a game. The Bearcats' lone loss this season was a 70-68 setback to Florida.

If the Huskers are able to defeat Montana State, Beck said she was looking forward to measuring up against Oregon State.

Besides the competition, Beck said, the tournament will also provide a chance for Husker senior Lis Brenden to return and compete in her home state.

Brenden was a Street and Smith's High School All-American selection as a senior at Silverton High School, and was the Oregon player of the year for the 1991-92 season.

"The reason we're going back there is because Lis Brenden is from that area and she's given me four good years," Beck said. "We're trying to take her back and showcase her and showcase her to some of her family members."

Brenden has started all three games this season and leads the team with eight steals.
