

LL Cool J "Mr. Smith" Def Jam Grade: B+

When I first encountered LL Cool J, he was a 17-year-old string bean who screamed his rhymes over slamming beats. That was 1986.

Ten years later, LL has been there and back.

Though he has not yet reached his goal of being "bigger than Michael Jackson," his albums are anticipated by his fans.

His last effort, "14 Shots to The Dome," was not his finest hour, to

say the least. But just like a modulating sine wave, LL has come back to the top.

"Mr. Smith" might be called a kinder, gentler LL, with fluid production from Easy Mo Bee. Contrasting with "Hey Lover," the sugar-filled duet with Boyz II Men, LL always includes the hardhitting track to squash all beef.

Read the line of "I Can't Live Without My Radio," "I'm Bad," "Droppin'Em,""Mama Said Knock You Out" and now, "I Shot Ya."

Two versions of the song appear. Not so surprisingly, the remix is the better version, with a little help from Keith Murray, Mobb Deep's Prodigy and Fat Joe.

Fans of the LL Cool J of 10 years past will not find any flashbacks, but what you will get is the new LL who is right on track. B-Boy ... Mack ... LL Cool J.
