# Student football tickets sold out

University of Nebraska-Lincoln students who did not apply for season tickets for the 1996 Cornhusker football season will have to wait another year.

The Nebraska Athletic Department ticket office is no longer accepting ticket applications for this season.

According to Nebraska Ticket

Manager Cindy Bell, all 8,400 student tickets have been sold. Last season, student tickets did not sell out.

The number of student tickets sold increased by about 2,000 over last year. Bell said back-to-back national championships have been the main reason for increased demand in ticket sales.

"There could be any number of reasons," Bell said. "After the first

championship, the demand went up. Then after last year it went up even more."

Demand for tickets are not limited to students. Bell said the faculty and general public have expressed increased interest in Husker football tickets as well.

Memorial stadium maintains the longest-running sellout streak at 208 home games.

The house, which has been used to house the University of Nebraska president, was damaged by a Jan. 18 fire.

NU President Dennis Smith was not living in the house at the time, but had \$150,000 of personal items destroyed in the blaze. The fire did \$650,000 total worth of damage to the house.
