A motion to suppress evidence in the case of former NU football player Riley Washington was denied in district court over the summer.

Defense attorneys for Washington asked the court to dismiss as evidence a set of photographs. Lincoln police showed the photographs to witnesses, some of whom identified Washington as the gunman in the 1995 shooting of Jermaine Cole.

On July 1, District Judge Bernard McGinn ruled that the photograph lineup was not unnecessarily suggestive of guilt, as the defense had claimed.

Last August, Washington pleaded not guilty to second-degree attempted murder for the shooting.

Witnesses in the case have been subpoenaed to appear in court again on Sept. 12.
