Two plays later, Brett Conway kicked a 28-yard field goal with 7:12 left in the half.

Just when it looked as if Paterno might give Enis a rest, back he went in the fourth quarter, running three times for 73 yards on the second touchdown drive. On his 57-yarder, he took a handoff from McQueary and ran around left end until he was forced out of bounds.


