mental variety. It's hard to find two songs to compare with each other on this disc. They range from the sad tale of self-exploration and defeat with "How the West was Won and Where it got Us" to "The Wake-up Bomb," laden with fat guitar licks and a tongue in cheek, arena rock attitude. The album is all over the place after that - Stipe dabbles with spoken word lyrics backed by flamboyant electric guitar on "Departure" while "Leave" harnesses a techno feel revolving with a gritty sense of urgency. Stipe's vocals seek to soothe the wavering, repeating backbeat as he slowly slurs out the answers.

And "Hi-Fi" reasserts R.E.M. as one of the most imaginative, talented and diverse bands of our time. Grade: B+
