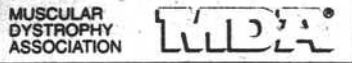

# NU golfers finish second in tourney

Sophomore Steve Friesen scored Nebraska's first individual title of the year as the Cornhusker men's golf team finished second to Drake in the Kansas Invitational in Lawrence, Kan., Tuesday.

Friesen fired a 4-under-par 212 over 54 holes, including a tournament-best 67 in the second round on Monday at the Alvarado Golf Club to defeat Missouri-Kansas City's Robert Russell and Drake's Zach Johnson by three strokes.

The Huskers led the tournament going into the final day by five strokes but shot a 305 on Tuesday, compared to Drake's 294.

Nebraska finished in a second-place tie with Colorado State at 23-over-par 887. The 305 was the worst score of three rounds for NU and 289 was Nebraska's best total. Sophomore Josh Madden

finished sixth with a 1-over par 217, while senior Trent Morrison placed 33rd with a score of 228. Senior Jacques Paiement tied for 37th at 230 and junior Scott Gutschewski tied for 59th at 235. All Nebraska golfers were in the top 60 for the second straight tournament.

The Kansas Invitational marked the third consecutive tournament in which NU has finished in the top five.

The Huskers were fifth at the Kiawah Intercollegiate in Kiawah Island, S.C., and the team won the Air Force Falcon-Cross Creek Tournament in Colorado Springs earlier this month.

The next tournament for Nebraska will be The Woodlands Intercollegiate in Houston, on Oct. 7 and 8.

Sam Houston State will play host to the tournament, held at The Players Championship Golf Course at The Woodlands, considered one of the top 100 courses in the nation.

down there. We couldn't hear Scott's audibles."

The Husker defense, which used hand signals, did not have major communication problems, but rush end Jared Tomich said the Huskers needed to be more dominant.

"Every week we try to go in and be the most physical team," Tomich said. "But they just came out and played a more physical game. Emotionally, we just weren't there."

Osborne said he was satisfied with the defensive turn-around in the second half.

Sam linebacker Jamel Williams led Nebraska with 17 tackles — the most by an NU player since 1981 — but Williams rated his performance as "fair."

"Basically, I'm just doing my job," Williams said. "I've got a lot to work on."

Will linebacker Terrell Farley will make his return to the playing field Saturday after serving a two-game suspension. Osborne said Farley will see significant playing time but will not start.

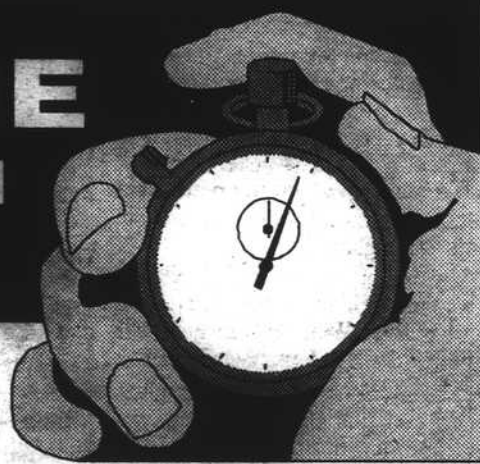

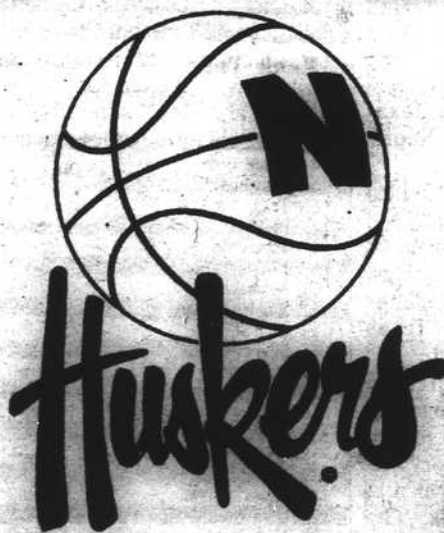
