

A step in the right direction



The fifth-annual event drew a record number of walkers and raised more than \$20,000 for the Nebraska AIDS Project. One walker raised \$2,000. David Keech, project chair, said most of the walkers were in their mid-30s. "The student turnout is disappointing," he said. 
