one who mixed fabrics were abominations unto God.

"The Bible is a gay-friendly book. There isn't a word in Hebrew for homosexual," he said.

"Most of my lifelong Christian friends had to walk away from me."

White now works as a free-lance writer, speaker and volunteer for the Metropolitan Community Church, which was founded 28 years ago by a gay minister.

He said he has forgiven those who have persecuted him.

"I have to remember they are just

victims of misinformation," he said. "Ghandi says we must bring truth in love relentlessly."

Dr. White will speak tonight at 7 p.m. in the Centennial Room at the Nebraska Union. The cost is \$2 for UNL students, \$3 for faculty and other students, and \$5 for the public.

The songs off "Three Feet High" drew much applause because they were easiest to sing along with, especially De La Soul's first big hit, "Me, Myself and I."

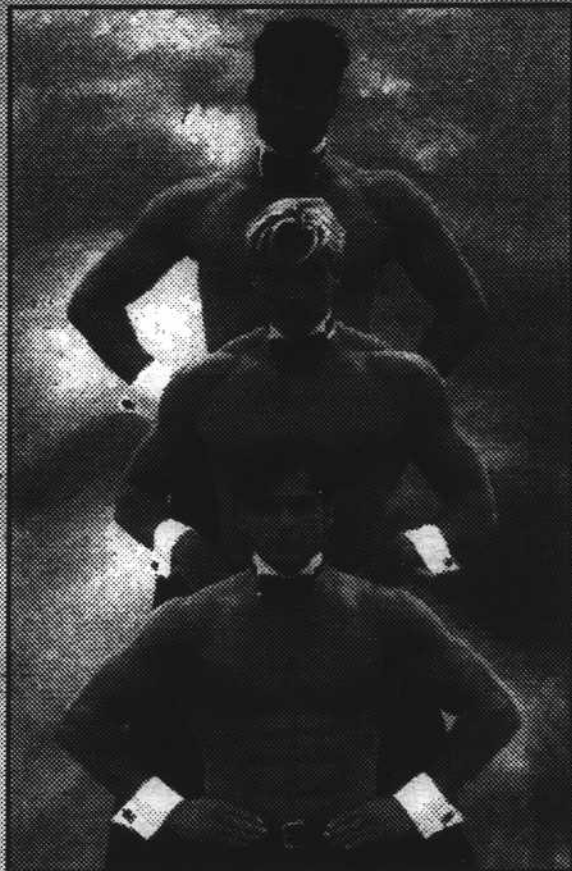

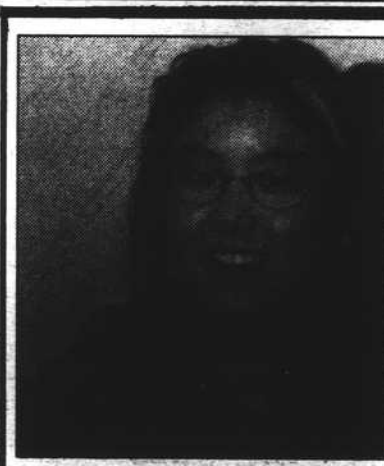
