season. The last time Nebraska posted back-to-back victories against a ranked foe — Sept. 6 and 7 against Michigan State — the Huskers lost on the road to unranked North Carolina the following week. Middle blocker Megan Korver said the Huskers have matured since that defeat.

"I think that last weekend will be a benefit to us," Korver said. "We know what it means to be overconfident. We've been hurt by it and we've learned from it."

First-year Coach Brian Hosfeld has turned Baylor's program around after last season's disappointing 7-28 season. Although the Bears have lost five of their last six matches, they have won three of their last four at home.

Baylor lists four returning starters on its roster, including Elisha Polk, who leads the team with 3.9 kills per game.

Texas Tech enters Saturday's match tied with No. 10 Texas for third place in the conference. Like Baylor, the Red Raiders return four starters from last

season's team, which finished third in the Southwest Conference.

Senior Jill Burness has been a force at the net this season for the Red Raiders, pounding a team-best 3.7 kills per game while hitting .345.

Nebraska plays Colorado at the NU Coliseum on Wednesday night before returning to the road next weekend to play Oklahoma.

"Knowing we're on the road shouldn't affect our play," Korver said. "It's only when we tune our minds into the fact that we don't have the crowd behind us, that's when it becomes a problem."
