Jury trials are essential, but there are areas that could be reformed, Kennedy said.

Kennedy said he thought the ability of lawyers to dismiss jurors based on race and sex -- called pre-emptory challenge - was unthinkable and should be disallowed.

Now, he said, lawyers, especially those representing the very wealthy,

A 45-year-old man had been stalking his ex-girlfriend for almost 10 months when Lincoln police arrested him Sunday.

Robert Murray Jr. allegedly fired three shots into his exgirlfriend's apartment Saturday morning, Sgt. Ann Heermann said. Murray and the woman, Lisa Jones, live in different apartments in the same building on the 4000 block of Dunn Avenue.

Jones was not at home when the shots were fired, Heermann said. Police later stopped Murray in

his car at the ShopKo at 27th Street and Highway 2, Heermann said. Police searched the car and

found a .357-caliber automatic handgun hidden in a pouch on the passenger side, Heermann said.

A search of Murray's apartment found a .22-caliber handgun. Police think shots fired into the apartment were .22-caliber rounds.

Murray was arrested for stalking, possession of a concealed weapon and criminal mischief.

On Oct. 16, Jones told police Murray had been calling her and leaving notes since January in attempts to get her back. On Wednesday, Murray left a CD and a note at her apartment, Heermann said.


Lincoln police arrested four boys breaking car windows at a salvage yard Sunday evening.
